- RFID Conversion Project is still underway. Non-fiction, YA, Oversized, Classics, JFIC, JGN, Easy Readers, Audiobooks, AFIC A-K etc., have been tagged. The collection has been maintained and weeded extensively according to condition, relevance, and demand.
